

PLEASE READ OUR COVID SAFETY PROTOCOLS BELOW:

We are pleased to have you join us at our venue, and are committed to making your visit a safe and enjoyable one. Because of that we have implemented the following protocols.

For the protection of our patrons, artists, staff members and volunteers. **all ticket holders must show proof of vaccination for COVID 19, or a negative test dated not more than 72 hours before the event, in order to purchase tickets**

While waiting for your turn to enter the building, please maintain social distance from other individuals/groups

- You may be asked to complete and sign a document confirming your wellness status and willingness to comply with these protocols.
- *Please note that if you don't feel well, or are showing signs of sickness during check-in, you MAY NOT come into the facility; you will be directed to return home.*

Check in will include the following:

- You may be asked to volunteer a self-assessment affirming the following to confirm that, to the best of your knowledge it is safe for you to enter the Hall
 - *No sore throat*
 - *No sneezing / No runny nose*
 - *No fever*
 - *To the best of your knowledge, you haven't been exposed to anyone with COVID-19 for at least 14 days*
- Temperature taken via non-contact infrared thermometer. If your temperature is over 99 degrees, you will not be allowed to enter
- Visual check that you are wearing a mask. Mask must cover both the nose and mouth (exceptions may be made for medical conditions which prohibit this with a note from your physician).

While you are in the Hall

- All patrons over 5 years old are required to wear a cloth or disposable mask except when eating.
- When waiting in line for concessions or the restrooms, patrons will maintain social distance of six feet from other individuals who are not in your party.

NOTE: Performers may remove masks when they are performing, but will be located at an appropriate social distance from the audience

We will update and adapt our policy as needed to follow the current safety guidelines.
